**DEFENCE YOUTH SAFETY TRAINING – LEVEL 1 AWARENESS
ARRANGEMENTS FROM 31 OCTOBER 2016**

1. Defgram 252/2016 introduced the first Defence Youth Safety eLearning package – Level 1 Awareness Training. Level 1 Awareness is the first of the planned six levels of training that will constitute the Defence youth safety training continuum. This continuum is designed to provide both adults and young people with the knowledge and skill required to respond appropriately to youth safety risks, youth safety incidents and allegations of abuse.
2. The Defence youth safety training continuum is being developed with the assistance of BraveHearts, who are partnered with Ernst and Young to deliver ChildPlace Health and Safety and realise the BraveHearts vision of making 'Australia the safest place in the world to raise a child by 2020'. The BraveHearts training team includes professionals from the fields of criminology, psychology and education.
3. Defence Youth Safety Level 1 Awareness is the minimum level of training required for all Defence personnel who may come into contact with young people under the age of 18 in the course of their regular duties.
4. To enable timely roll out, Level 1 Awareness was initially hosted externally by BraveHearts. From 31 October 2016 Level 1 awareness training will be available via CAMPUS and CAMPUS anywhere:
 - a. by searching using the key words "defence youth";
 - b. Course Code - 214570; and
 - c. Proficiency Number - P108378.
5. PMKeYS recording of course completion for all personnel who accessed the externally hosted Level 1 Awareness e-Learning package during the period July – October 2016 is being actioned with the assistance of the Directorate of Customer Access Management (DCAM) and is due for completion by the end of November 2016.
6. The Defence Youth Safety Training Guide direction for training completion has been updated to reflect that:
 - a. all Defence personnel and contractors whose primary role involves interaction with young people under the age of 18 are to complete L1 awareness training before commencing in the role,
 - b. all Defence personnel and contactors already in a role that involves interaction with young people under the age of 18 are to complete L1 awareness training within the next 30 days.
