Dear Scott

I refer to my letter to you dated 12 February 2010 offering you employment as Swimming Queensland Head Coach (redesignated since then as Swimming Queensland Mentor Coach). That offer, which was accepted by you, was subject to you complying at all times with the conditions imposed upon you as a recipient of a negative notice issued by the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian.

As you are aware, Swimming Queensland has sought and obtained advice from the Commission as to whether certain activities you, as a negative notice holder, are undertaking in the performance of your duties would be considered to fall within the scope of regulated employment under the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian Act 2000.

Based on the information Wayne Lomas and I have provided to the Commission, the Commission has determined that certain of these activities are regulated by the Act and, as such, will need to be reviewed by Swimming Queensland to avoid a potential breach of the Act by both Swimming Queensland and you.

To that end, I am attaching to this letter the relevant extract of the advice from the Commission for your information.

I look forward to continuing to work with you in the role of Mentor Coach and to us taking every precaution to ensure that we comply fully with the Commission's advice at all times. This will include your documenting all activities you propose to undertake and obtaining my written approval before proceeding.
