Hari Om,

I just spoke with Terry, and as usual, it was perfect timing and exactly what we need.

So, he's had some contact from various people, I don't know who, but it seems to be in response to the letter we sent to victims. He didn't give me details but

the gist of it is that they trust him and are therefore wanting one to one attention.

To proceed he wants a meeting next week at Mangrove with the leadership. This means the management committee plus Vivek and Hriday, plus I suggested Bert as HR consultant/TF and Poornamurti. He needs the key decision makers and on the basis of that meeting he will decide whether to continue being involved. This is because he will only continue with us if he believes the leadership are totally committed to his process. I sense the possibility that victims who have been in touch with him are saying that there are still skeletons in the closet which are not being acknowledged. That's just my feeling. This meeting can take place on Monday, Tuesday, Wed morning or Friday. I suggest that Yogasandhan do the legwork on this one. It would be best if Suryamitra was there.

I also talked with him about the Haribodh issue. He says that we will not get past the perceived conflict of interest that they are homing in on, not at this stage anyway. So let's hold off on the explanations. I asked how we should respond to communications in the meantime and he advised that we should now say that we are hearing people's responses and taking their issues to the meeting with Terry and MM leadership in order to determine the way forward.

As far as a session with victims, his preferred approach will be to do one to one work with those who are most vocal and allow that to trickle down to the others. As these people's journeys develop, there may come a time for a group meeting. But the leadership meeting next week is now the crux of the matter for us.

He clearly wants me not to be caught doing the 'heavy lifting' - rather it should be assumed by those with whom the responsibility does lie. This reflects the direction the task force is taking in trying to return the work to MM. His involvement and recognition will support that process, and I'll pull back now if that shift can become more real.

Thanks for all your patience with the discussions we've been having. You are a really brilliant, kind and sincere group of people to work with, and for me that's as important an experience as any of the solutions that may or may not come out of it all.

If Yoga can get back asap about a plan for a meeting, then another communication can be sent out to those who have been in direct correspondence. This could come from Mangrove as part of shifting the job back to them, and as the meeting is theirs, not the task force's. She could also do the communication with Terry to plan the details.

Our names are a big problem to him. Perhaps normal names could be used for the meeting?? It's just a practical thing. He currently can't identify people which is a handicap. Except for Bert of course.
