On the back page I note with concern [CIE] grabbed [redacted]'s hair.

We know [redacted] and her grandmother well as well as [redacted] her mother.

I was told of the incident but not of the attack on Royce.

My parental discipline was to place [CIE] in his room around 4:30 and he had to stay there for an hour. He then went and apologized to [redacted] the next day.

I was not aware of the problem with Royce so I could not discuss it with [CIE]. Agains there was a failure to inform the parent fully even when it is on your records that I asked for this.

The result of this is I dod not have a chance to discuss with [CIE] why he was attacking him again he ([CIE]) liked him. This was not the case at all and I see Royce was not at all suitable

The dolphin Cruise account is even more worrying. Again the same scenario.

I wonder if you realize that if continued

Attacks are not reported the behaviour is very difficult to deal with. There is no discussion to find out what is going on, it can become entrenched and I think your staff are needing more fuller education.
