To whom it may concern,

During an interview with Susan Booth, we discussed the beginnings of a behaviour management plan. In that meeting I made the observation that Royce was not encouraging [CIE] to join in with others.

He needs this, I could see [CIE] was isolated from the rest of the group. I think Royce was telling him to pack up and I am sure I mentioned I was pleased [CIE] complied.

However there was no attempt from Royce to include [CIE] in the group from what I could see.

I saw the need to talk about inclusion and how to do it as I had spent the last five years at school practicing this and there are little things you can do to put it into practice.

I had also offered to stay a while and help [CIE] settle into appropriate activities.

There was no such meeting. The Disability Trust needs to realize with a boy like [CIE] the parents are the experts and they need to acknowledge their concerns. This goes across the board on everything to do with their child.

The Disability Trust needs far more transparency and education in caring for disability children.

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8/1/2012 – Record of requesting meeting due to Royce not encouraging to socialize – not followed through

- Holding his arm – specifically told them not to do this
- Better communication – very little if any
- They told me [CIE] like Royce over and over again
- Healed himself – [CIE] had told me he had no hearing problems and had been healed (his words)

Behaviour on Dolphin Cruise shows [CIE] is extremely upset – I was not told of the degree of this. Was he alone with Royce at any part of the day?

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Have asked for accounts from other staff members of this excursion

Locking him in his rom all night and morning

- He does not have a lock on his door and he is not locked up 'all night and morning'. This mindset indicates they have misinterpreted my son.

No issues outdoors because – no abuse

- Complained that incidents need to be reported more fully
Its on record, they did not
