**Re: Request for release of information under Chapter 16A of the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998***

I refer to your email dated 10 December 2012 in which you sought information from New South Wales Police Force under Chapter 16A of the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998* (the Act) relating to the child CIE [REDACTED] born [REDACTED] 1996.

Section 245D of the Act allows a prescribed body to request another prescribed body to provide information they hold that relates to the safety, welfare or wellbeing of a particular child or young person or class of children or young persons. Section 245C allows a prescribed body to provide information.

Now South Wales Police Force is releasing the information contained in this letter on the basis that there is a lawful reason to do so, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 16A.
