**RE: ROYCE COMBER**

As part of our ongoing investigation involving Mr Royce Comber, The Disability Trust was required to notify the NSW Commission for Children and Young People of a Relevant Employment Proceeding concerning allegations made concerning Mr Comber.

An email was sent by Mr Ryan Kiddle on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2012 which included a copy of a Relevant Employment Proceedings Notification and Summary form. This form indicated a Category 1 notification in which there was some evidence that showed the allegations may be sustained. I have confirmed today that this email was received but not entered on to the system.

Further investigations with the NSW Police and Department of Community Services have found a number of inconsistencies in reports and our own investigation processes which are now completed did not support this conclusion. We have now amended our finding to "Not Sustained – Insufficient Evidence".

In light of the new evidence, The Disability Trust is seeking to modify our position and wishes to withdraw our Category 1 notification.
