Dear Brigadier Reddie,

I refer to our earlier discussions this year covering a number of matters and in particular, in relation to the future of the Endeavour Training Farm, Riverview. I understand that at the recent Christmas party at Endeavour, mention was made of this phase of your activities coming to a conclusion.

I am now seeking from you some official confirmation of your intentions in relation to the Endeavour Training Farm as a licensed institution for children and in particular, would like confirmation relating to the closure of the institution and your wishes for the Mulgowie property where there are some children in care in the period between now and when this property's facilities are re-directed for the purpose you are discussing with the Department of Health. On the closure of the Endeavour Training Farm as an institution, the licence should be returned to me for cancellation.

Perhaps it will be necessary for us to arrange discussions relating to the interim period and the Mulgowie property and also in relation to the future allocation of any equipment at Riverview which was fully supplied at this Department's expense.

I shall look forward to hearing from you shortly so that a mutually satisfactory finalization of these matters will be achieved.
