Dear Brigadier Reddie,

I am writing to you concerning the incident at "Alkira" on the evening of 22nd April, 1975, and the use of corporal punishment.

Your attention is drawn to Regulation 23 of the Children's Services Regulations, in particular Sub-Regulations 4, 5(d) and 10. From the reports received by me concerning this incident, it would seem that the punishment was overly severe and outside the intent of the Regulations.

I draw this matter to your attention and trust that you will be able to ensure that the means of discipline at "Alkira" has regard to the Regulations, and every effort shall be made to enforce discipline without the use of corporal punishment.
