

No. 1. A statement provided by Robert Spencer -

INFORMATION FROM [REDACTED] WHO IS CONCERNED ABOUT A CONVERSATION HE HAD WITH ATJ [REDACTED] ON THE EVENING OF 1ST SEPTEMBER.

NOTE: [REDACTED] had not seen [ATJ] since they left school. It was a chance meeting in the city.

[ATJ] was in the same group as [ATP] and [REDACTED] (4th class about 1970).

He lived in [REDACTED].

[ATJ] told [REDACTED] that he was about to bring litigation against Knox Prep. and Barrie Stewart, claiming that Barrie Stewart sexually interfered with him while giving him lifts to school in his car.

[ATJ] says he has nothing to lose in bringing this litigation because he ([ATJ]) is gay.

Apparently at the time [ATJ] parents sent a letter on the subject to Dr Paterson, to which he replied.

[ATJ] is about to start work for the Sydney 2000 Olympic bid organisation.

[REDACTED] contacted me on this matter because it concerned him that such litigation could be forthcoming, and he thought that the school and Barrie Stewart should be forewarned.
