

## HEADMASTER'S REPORT TO COUNCIL

### ADDENDUM

1. Nyngan Flood
  - (a) We have amassed a truckload of clean clothes, heaters and the like and sent it to the Uniting Church at Narromine from where it will be distributed. Senior boys did this especially.
  - (b) We have offered our Senior Cadets to the S.E.S. to assist, in any way, with the reconstitution of Nyngan. Our offer is getting attention now and we may go up in the last week of School - first week of holidays this term. We would be entirely self-contained and require no shelter, food etc. or other resources from the town. Several senior Cadets and Officers independently broached the idea to me some time ago.
  - (c) The **REDACTED** Family has a boy at Knox. The father is a solicitor and his business is substantially wiped out - most records gone and there will be no business for him for some time. I suggest we offer immediate free place for the boy for the rest of this year when the situation can be re-assessed - maybe an OKGA Trust Fund one?
2. Stuart Pearson has resigned (from Term 3 end) as he has "outgrown the position" of School disciplinarian. His recent marriage also contributed to a desire to seek another position where his investigative talents can be more fruitfully used. This is his ninth year at Knox.
