NSW INSTITUTE OF SPORT COACH CODE OF ETHICS

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person with whom they have contact in the course of the program and its implementation
2. Be fair , considerate and honest with athletes
3. Do not engage in physical, verbal and emotional abuse of athletes
4. Respect the talent, potential and developmental stage and goals of each athlete under their care
5. Ensure that all athletes receive an appropriate level of attention and opportunities so that their time spent in any program is a positive experience
6. Show concern for the health, safety and welfare of athletes
7. Do not engage in sexual harassment of athletes or physical contact with athletes which is unwelcome and / or represents an abuse of power which has a sexual element to it.
8. Refrain from physical contact with athletes except where necessary for the development of the athletes skill or athletic ability
9. Display control, respect, dignity and professionalism towards all those with whom they come into contact during the course of their duties including opponents, other coaches, officials, administrators, parents, the media and spectators
10. Maintain high professional behaviour standards at all times as representatives of NSWIS and their sport
