Following your letter of 14 April 2003, we conducted enquiries in relation to the allegations Mr Williams has made about ^{CLI} and the claim that The King's School was aware of ^{CLI} propensity to carry out such assaults. We have made enquiries both with the students and the staff member, whom Mr Williams claims were aware of the alleged propensity of ^{CLI}. We have received from these individuals categorical denials of any knowledge of ^{CLI} alleged propensity, or any awareness that Mr Williams had been the subject of such alleged assaults.

In light of the outcome of these enquiries, we are unable to offer any monetary amount to Mr Williams. If Mr Williams chooses to pursue the matter with the police or any other government authority, we will certainly co-operate with him.

As indicated in our conference on 28 November 2002, I welcome periodic contact with Mr Williams, if that would assist him. As an Old Boy of the School, we wish to assist Mr Williams as best we can.
