I act for EAA EAB, the parents of CLA (REDACTED, 1986) a student at your school and a resident in the school boarding house (School House).


My clients wish to express their shock and dismay in learning from the NSW Department of Community Services that CLA has alleged that he was repeated sexually assaulted by two other Year 10 students at Trinity Grammar while attending the boarding house over the past year.

On behalf of my clients it is requested that Trinity Grammar School provide a concise explanation and account of how these events, which have since been substantiated by numerous witnesses, have occurred while their son was in the care of the school.

That explanation and account is required in order that my clients as CLA parents can make clear and informed decisions on behalf of their son as to his future options at Trinity Grammar and to ensure that his welfare is being attended to now that he has returned to the school.

As you would appreciate my clients are extremely distressed and the situation is placing extreme pressures on the whole REDA Family. Consequently a reply within 14 days of the date of this letter would be greatly appreciated.
