Re: DFB

We act on behalf of DFB who you have asked to stay away from school for the time being.

On Friday 6 October 2000, our client's parents received a telephone call from Mr Peter Green, indicating that DOCS were investigating certain allegations and that DFB was to be removed from school for the time being.

We might say that we find this procedure most unusual since there has been no formal allegation against our client in relation to his behaviour. It would appear to us that our client has been 'tried' prior to being able to be heard in relation to any supposed allegations.

Our client is not aware that he presents any danger to any other pupils at the school, and accordingly, we believe that DFB should be allowed to return to school forthwith and attend all normal classes and participate in all usual events.



Would you also supply to us the full names and qualifications of the school counsellors who we understand have been the people conducting the investigation in this matter.

Since our client is losing precious time at school, and the commencement of year 11 work is imperative for senior studies (although he is in year 10), it is vital that these matters be attended to immediately. Any delay in investigations or you supplying the information we have requested, is prejudicial to our client and we urge you to therefore act immediately.
