We want to help you in any way we can and would ask you to send us a written statement of your experiences whilst you were in Riverview Boys Home. Please include in this written statement:

- The date you were admitted to and discharged from the Home
- Details of your experience that you can remember, including the names of Staff and or Salvation Army Officers
- The impact on your life from being in care

We understand that this process can be difficult. When we have received your Impact Statement your case will be presented at our Personal Injuries Committee meeting which is held once a month. The Committee will then make a recommendation on how we can best offer support to you.
