SUBJECT: SEXUAL AND OTHER ABUSE & THE SALVATION ARMY

Following the recommendations of the Working Party of which you are a member, I advise that any further correspondence or inquiries regarding complaints and/or allegations should be sent direct to the Chief Secretary.

I am dictating this letter prior to the meeting of the Working Party on Friday 14 June, however at that meeting I will table a revised procedure and a flow chart which has been approved by the Territorial Commander at Cabinet, and has been referred to the Southern Territory. As soon as we have a 'nominated person' the complainant will be referred to this 'nominated person', then simultaneously any information concerning the complaint and/or allegation will be sent to the Chief Secretary.

In view of this procedure, your letter dated 13 June concerning FV has been referred to the Chief Secretary for his attention, and I understand he will be writing and authorising counselling for FV.
