Hi Matt,

I confirm that this matter was listed for directions yesterday afternoon before Judicial Registrar Howard. Luke Geary appeared for TSA and Paul Cummins appeared on behalf of Ralph Doughty.

Luke advised that TSA was ready to take a hearing date. However, Mr Cummins submitted that his client desired to put on further evidence in response to the Affidavits served by TSA.

Accordingly, the Judicial Registrar made the following orders:

1. Plaintiff to serve any Reply evidence by 14 June 2013;
2. proceedings listed for hearing on 22 and 23 August 2013; and
3. standard orders for hearing.

These applicable standard orders for hearing are:

1. Plaintiff's solicitor is to prepare a full chronology of relevant events, a copy of which is to be served upon the other party at least three clear days prior to the hearing date.
2. Each party is to prepare a schedule of damages and a schedule of issues which is to be served upon the other party at least three days prior to the hearing date and copies of those schedules are to be provided to the trial judge.
3. All cases should be ready to proceed on the hearing date and adjournments will only be granted in exceptional circumstances. Any application for an adjournment must be made by way of Notice of Motion with affidavit in support and must be made at the earliest possible time.
