Donna, thanks so much for your email. I am very grateful for your responsible action. This is exactly what we have been looking for.

Thanks for sharing what you heard about the event or events in **REDACTED**. This will be added to the files, and will give additional protection to the Army, and enable us to build a better picture.

I can say that Colin's case has been very carefully managed now for a number of years.

You are wise to raise the concern for our own people. It will be a shock to many when witnesses are reported from the Commission and when facts emerge. I think you are right, that we need to prepare them, and we will be trying to do that. Better to make revelations ourselves in our own way, ahead of time, than for people to get it from the media.

Over the past few weeks we have had a team trawling through all our files, pulling out data for the Commission, and that will give us as of today a very detailed picture. Letters from persons such as yourself have also assisted us in building a picture of how allegations were managed in the past. So we are now able to describe things fairly well—even better than we could have six months ago.

The TC is going to re-run the advert we did years ago for a while in Pipeline: Zero Tolerance on sexual misconduct, and will ask soldiers to report any incidents.

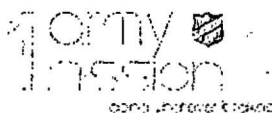
Thanks again. If you would like to talk further in person I am happy to do that.
