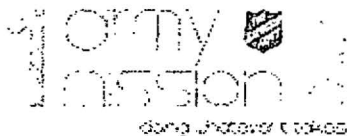

In response to the Commissioners email today regarding the Royal Commission, I am aware of an incident that happened a long time ago at REDAC Corps. This incident was brought to my attention

before I took up my appointment there in late 2009. My husband **RED** and myself had had lunch with the Officer, then Major Colin Haggar when he informed **RED** about an incident with himself and an underage female Corps member. Colin wanted us to know incase it came up during our time there as a previous Officer had been approached by the girls mother. During our appointment at **REDAC** we (the Corps) were collecting on a show gates when the girls mother walked past and started yelling to those coming and going, 'don't give to them, one of them molested my daughter'. Whilst the lady did not name anyone in her rant, I reported the incident to Major Warren Parkinson when they were on a visit to the Corps not long after.
