I asked Major Holley in your absence to instruct him to cease visiting in institutions in the name of the Army until the situation can be clarified.

The Chief Secretary told me that **REDACTED** who was an Officer at one time initiated one of the complaints and I asked him to contact **REDACTED** and hear what she has to say.

I asked Major Holley to respond direct to the Chief Secretary, hopefully on the same day however, I understand that to date no report has been made. Can you please follow through with this matter and on the word of the Chief Secretary treat the report as urgent.
