Dear Colonel,

REDACTED and I have, after much struggling and prayer, decided that following the seminar at the Training College we will take 8 months sick leave. During this time I will hope to complete my Bachelor of Theology course in Melbourne, graduating in May of next year.

I would like to enter the College in Melbourne on 18th September, which will be two weeks later than the commencement of the semester, but I hope this will give you time to find someone to replace us. This will allow us to pack and vacate the quarters. **REDACTED** will be living in a caravan behind our daughters home while **REDACTED** finishes his Higher School Certificate exams.

As you know I have experienced nearly three years of bad health and I have to recover somehow. **REDACTED** feels absolutely run down and unable to carry on the Corps responsibility while I recuperate. She too needs the break from the Army work. By studying God's word and having a much slower pace, I hope to regain my health. We do not wish to be dependent on the Army and a burden.

I know you will appreciate our concern and that this is not a decision lightly made. We will plan to move out on 15th September 1982.
