I wish to advise you that I have already made letters of protest or complaint to the following Officers, Mrs Lieut Colonel Cairns, Brigadier Ruth Smith, and Major Leah Davids. These letters being a complaint & very much a protest at the continued presence of Captain Wilson.

This man presents himself as a Marriage Guidance Counsellor & says much that implies he is well up in the field of ~~psych~~ psychiatry, & says also "he is a medical man". He owns & will use a stethoscope. Has stated publicly how he checked a woman's heart condition. I consider that this is just too much for him to make these claims, they take advantage of the individual woman's trust in him as a minister of Christ.

He does not need any encouragement to speak to single, or widowed women about their sexual urges, & makes accusations for which there is not necessarily any real foundations.
