Thanks for your request about Mr Ray CARLILE. This is the only Ray CARLILE matter I can locate and would expect this to be the man concerned.

Please confirm that the audio file you have reviewed also correlates to the information summarised from the file.

The file about our contact with Mr Ray CARLILE provides the following summarised background material:

- PSO first became aware of Mr Carlile when he was featured in an article in the Courier Mail, Brisbane on 16/11/2009. (Copy attached.) This article details some of the abuse suffered by him at the hands of Salvation Army Officers in about 1956 at Riverview Boys Home.
- 16/11/2009 was the day of the Commonwealth apology to Forgotten Australians by Prime Minister Rudd.
- As a result of this article Mr Carlile was contacted by Professional Standards in December 2009.
- A number of personal visits were made to Mr Carlile and his family in an effort to understand what had happened and to understand what assistance might best suit Mr Carlile.
- A period of review and assessment resulted in a claim before our Personal Injuries Complaints Committee (PICC) being decided. The information provided by Mr Carlile and also collected by Professional standards officers details some horrible and severe abuse by a number of officers. There appears to have been significant affects on Mr Carlile from this abuse.
- Mr Carlile accepted an offer of \$100,000 (gross) from the TSA in March 2010.
- Mr Carlile contacted PSO again in June 2011 and he was assisted with advice and some services. In July 2011 he ask for a further payment. (Peter was the Case Manager in 2011 and will have a more detailed knowledge.)
- Mr Carlile's claim was again reviewed thoroughly and sympathetically and some additional professional advice was sought and provided to assist further review over the next three months.
- The PICC determined in October 2011 that it was not able to make a further payment to Mr Carlile as he had already received the maximum possible payment.
- When Mr Carlile was regretfully informed of the PICC's decision, TSA's assistance in other non-financial ways was offered to Mr Carlile and his family and Mr Carlile was invited to contact the PSO.
- There is no record on the file on any further activity and TSA's offer of other assistance could still be taken up by Mr Carlile.

Riverview will be the site of a reunion of care leavers this next weekend, Sunday 05/08/2012. (I believe David Godkin and Peter and Veronika Hatte are planing to attend.)
