

MEMORANDUM OF TELEPHONE ATTENDANCES

re LANE

Today (16th September 1996) Peter Marr from the Child Exploitation Unit rang and wanted some information regarding this case -

1. Date Red Shield Appeal would have been held in 1975
2. Ages of Junior Soldiers & Corps Cadets
3. Information from Murgon & Mitchelton Corps - History Books and Y.P. Rolls

I was able to find out information regarding items 1 and 2 and rang that through to Peter Marr on 17th September 1996.

The DC wrote letters to Mitchelton & Murgon Corps Officers requesting that the History Books and Y.P. Rolls be delivered to DHQ.

These books were in DHQ by Monday 23rd September 1996. I rang Lt. Colonel Jessop and informed him that the History Books and Y.P. Rolls were here and just ran past him that I would ring Peter Marr and let him know that they were here for him to look at. Lt. Colonel Jessop said that was OK - but to get a receipt for anything he took with him.

I rang Peter Marr and informed him that I had the Books. He came and looked at them that day. He was not interested in the History Books (but did read them) but would want to take the Y.P. Rolls away. He said he would obtain a Warrant and then come back.

On Wednesday 25th September 1996 Peter Marr rang to say that he had the Warrant and would come up to collect the Y.P. Rolls. He called at approximately 11.15 p.m. and produced the Warrant (a copy is attached) and I handed the Y.P. Rolls to him. There was 1 Roll for Mitchelton and 3 for Murgon (2 were old ones that had been re-written). I obtained a receipt for these. (see attached).

Peter Marr said they should be finished with them in about a weeks time, and will deliver them back to me.
