- \$125,000 – ex-gratia payment
- \$ 25,000 - costs
- \$ 12,000 - counselling

## REPORT TO PICC

### CONCLUSION:

The abuse experiences exacerbated his speech and learning disability. He left the home very traumatised and used alcohol to numb the pain. He has attempted suicide 4 times. He suffers from co morbid depression.

Recommendation that as well as an ex-gratia payment that ER is offered the counselling support needed to address these issues.
