You will be familiar with Mr. given your involvement in accompanying Mr. Ian Whitehead to visit him in Ararat Prison in December, 1996.

Although the file indicates clearly that Mr. had no intention of seeking any monetary compensation from The Salvation Army for the alleged abuse received whilst in the care of The Salvation Army Bexley Boys Home, we have now received correspondence in which he is applying for compensation.

Given the circumstances it is not unexpected that there is no report in the file from Mr. Ian Whitehead as a result of his visit but it would be useful for our deliberations if you were able to furnish us with a report from your perspective on this visit.

I recognise that it is quite some time since you travelled to Victoria for this purpose but perhaps you have some diary notes and if so I would appreciate it if you could forward me a report under Private and Confidential cover for review at the next meeting of the Personal Injury Claims Committee.

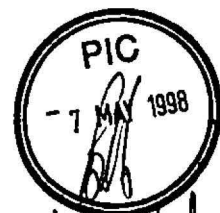
Your co-operation in this matter is very much appreciated.
