Dear Matt,

I confirm that I appeared with Ms Kate Eastman SC before Judicial Registrar Howard in the District Court today. Mr Doughty was represented by his employee, Mr Cummins.

Mr Doughty remains in default of an order that he serve all of his evidence in this case by 21 February 2013. Ms Eastman SC thought that the best strategy to take with Mr Doughty was that we give him one further chance to serve his evidence and failing that, seek an order that he not be entitled to rely upon any evidence at the trial. I note that you and I agreed with this approach.

Accordingly, by consent today the following orders were made:

1. Plaintiff to serve all evidence upon which he intends to rely by 26 April 2013. In the event that the Plaintiff does not serve his evidence by 31 May 2013, then he will not be permitted to rely upon any such evidence at trial;
2. Defendant to serve any evidence in response by 24 May 2013;
3. Proceedings listed for directions hearing at 2pm on 6 June 2013;
4. Costs of today reserved.

I will advise further as this matter develops.
