

TO THE A/SENIOR PROBATION OFFICER

RE: EDEN PARK BOYS' HOME,
MOUNT BARKER.

As requested I visited this home on 10/6/65 in company with Mr. R. Maslen.

Brigadier Lawler stated that there were no children in his care who were under the age of 7 years.

As Mr. Maslen had not seen the new buildings which were opened approximately 12 months ago Brigadier Lawler kindly showed us through this establishment. At present only part of the proposed plan has been completed and this consists of 2 wings each designed to approximate a cottage establishment. Each Wing contains 4 dormitories of 6 beds each and has separate rooms for dressing, showering, homework and for evening entertainment. The Home was relatively clean and tidy. Staffing still remains a problem with only 4 male Officers and some 3 females plus domestics for some 40 children.
