BY virtue of the provisions of the Maintenance Act, 1926-1941, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby abolish as a probationary school and as an institution for the reception, detention, maintenance, education, employment, and training of Protestant boys who are State children the private institution situate at Mount Barker in the said State, and known as the Mount Barker Boys' Home and called "The Eden" in the proclamation hereinafter referred to, being the lands and premises which were by proclamation dated the 5th day of December, 1900, and published in the Government Gazette of the 20th day of December, 1900, at page 1382, proclaimed a probationary school and institution as aforesaid.
