Memorandum to the Honourable the Chief Secretary.

In August 1941 Cabinet approved of Wards of the Department being removed from the Boys' Probationary School at Wistow. On the same date it was decided that further consideration should be given to the question of abolishing the institution as a proclaimed private institution in accordance with the Maintenance Act. Shortly afterwards all State Wards in this institution were removed by the Board, and the Salvation Army have carried on this institution with their own private boys. In view of the fact that a recommendation has been made that the Girls' Probationary School at Fullarton be abolished immediately at the request of the Salvation Army Authorities and with the approval of the Board, I feel that the time is appropriate to consider abolishing in the same notice the Boys' Probationary School at Mount Barker.

I recommend accordingly.
