Our Sydney agents have forwarded to us the statement made by you concerning your experiences at the Eden Park Children's Home. We appreciate and thank you for the time and effort you took to get to Sydney to make such a statement. Please let us have details of your travel expenses and we will seek reimbursement on your behalf.

The Salvation Army have also asked us to thank you for recounting your experiences at the home and appreciate that it would have been extremely distressing for you to convey such information to a stranger. The Salvation Army is deeply disturbed and saddened by the revelations contained in your statement.

We have asked the Army to make inquiries to see who of the various adults named by you are still alive in order that they may be interviewed and your statement put to them. Further, in order for us to consider your request for compensation, we would like to obtain a report from any counsellors, medical practitioners or psychiatrists who have counselled or treated you as a result of your treatment at Eden Park. Could you kindly therefore please sign the enclosed authorities, in consultation with your own legal advisor if you wish, and return them to us as soon as possible so that we can obtain such reports.
