Graham,

I confirm my telephone advice to you earlier today that proceedings by Graham Rundle were commenced in The Supreme Court of N.S.W on 25 March 2003 against both the Salvation Army( South Australia) Property Trust and Keith Ellis.

At the same time a Notice of Motion fixed for hearing on 14 April 2003 was also issued. Such notice seeks an order for an extension of time to issue proceedings pursuant to the relevant South Australian statute.

In summary the proceedings allege:

- Sexual assaults at Eden Park Boys Home, by other boys for a period five years once or twice a week.
- Assault and battery by Ellis approximately one hundred times.

I will forward you a copy of the Court documents shortly. In the meantime we will consider and advise the Army generally, including advice about the following:

- The merit of the claim for an extension of time;
- Whether application ought be made to seek a transfer of the proceedings to South Australia;
- Tactics generally,
