The Salvation Army

We refer to our telephone conversation with you on 7 June 2000.

It is our opinion and also that of the Salvation Army that you and REDACTED ought take your complaints concerning alleged criminal behaviour to the police.

We confirm that a Willem Willemsen born on 14 April 1925 was charged by Detective Senior Constable Wickham of the Box Hill CIB. Willemsen made a full statement to Prahran Police and whilst he made admissions of a number of indecent assaults, it is fair to say that his admissions were of a less numerous and less disgusting acts of indecency than were complained of. Willemsen made no admissions of physical abuse. In any event he pleaded guilty to three counts of indecent assault. It appears that a suspended jail term of some sort was imposed.

I have written the same letter to your brother REDACTED and would be grateful if you could let us know whether or not you intend to complain to the police.
