Tony,

We are grateful for the work that has gone into your letter of advice dated 29 May 1997.

We are now attempting to put the model in place as a matter of uniform policy between the Army's Southern Territory and the Army's Eastern Territory.

Not surprisingly, the pressure is mounting in Perth from victims seeking the Army's response to claims for compensation, and I can see we are going to need further detailed assistance from Parker & Parker in each individual case, once the policy framework is in place.

The guidelines for counselling referred to on page 3 are not yet in place, and we will come back to you on that.

We agree that it would be useful for you to prepare "without prejudice" agreements referred to on page 8.
