Further to our conversation of yesterday evening, I now have to hand a personal report from Major Russell Adams. He supplies this along with the full details of Captain's dealings with **REDACTED**, photocopies of which are attached herewith. My assessment of the information given in this report, is that there is no substantiated evidence that, I consider, would be sufficient to challenge the Captain on.

However, in the light of the revelation of former problems interstate, I feel that we should re-consider his appointment to the Youth Training Centre, Bayswater. My reason for this being that the Captain would be subjected to a situation with problematic people which could bring about his seduction and ultimate downfall as a Salvation Army Officer.

I would be grateful if you would give this your immediate consideration.
