Barbara,


You have asked whether IHQ has been notified of the Allan Smith case.

Following the events of 27 February 1997, when Allan pleaded guilty to the 74 offences with which he was charged, Commissioner Howe urgently arranged a number of internal meetings to plan the Army's response in view of the high degree of media interest and victim aggravation.

The setting up of the internal Monitoring Task Force was one such initiative.

I have a clear recollection that in one of these early meetings, Commissioner Howe indicated that he would inform IHQ of the events concerning Allan, and the substantial financial implication of claims from victims.
