**Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse (the Commission):
 Case Study 33: The Salvation Army (Southern Territory)**

We refer to your letter dated 22 September 2015 in which you asked us to confirm the total amount paid to former residents of The Salvation Army (Southern Territory) (TSAS) operated institutions.

We have reviewed the "Schedule B" spreadsheets provided by our client to the Commission in response to the Summons to Produce identified below. From reviewing these spreadsheets, we confirm that the total amount that has been paid by TSAS to former residents is as follows:

Total from 1 January 1995 to 31 December 2014	418	\$17,999,325.30


