I rang John HERBERT and told him that I was going to Andrew's house, on The Estate. I borrowed the school car and drove around. I knocked twice on the front door, but there was no answer. I walked around the house and saw that the blinds were down on all windows. I looked through a crack in the garage doors and saw that his car was there, but both garage doors were locked. I was puzzled but thought that Andrew might have gone somewhere to seek advice about his dismissal. I did not go into the back porch area to test the back door.
