OWN MOTON INQUIRY- RABBI AVROHOM GLICK

I refer to the Victorian Institute of Teaching's ('the Institute') previous communications to you in the above matter and to your letter of 5 March 2014.

As previously advised, the Institute were acting on information gleaned from criminal proceedings against a Mr David Cyprys.

Under the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* (Vic) s2.6.33A (c), the Institute may investigate a matter relating to a registered teacher without a compliant or employer notification if the Institute reasonably believes the teacher is unfit to teach. On 23 October 2013, the Institute's Disciplinary Proceedings Committee ('the Committee') decided to investigate the information received.

Following an investigation, this matter was tabled for further consideration by the Committee at its meeting on 12 March 2014. The Committee decided not to take any further action in relation to this matter on the basis that the teacher, on the material received, had no case to answer.

If you could ensure that your client is aware of the Institute's decision and I thank you for your help in bringing this matter to conclusion.
