STATES— In 1965 I was a student at St. Joseph's College in Mildura. At this time I was one of the elder boys and I was aged 14 years. I was in Form 1 at the time.

I believe that in February 1965 Father DAY and myself travelled down to Melbourne in his car, and the both of us stayed at Father DAY's sisters place, in Williamstown. I do not know the name of the street or the number of the house.

When we arrived at Father DAY's sisters home, I had no pyjamas with me, as at this stage my mother had died and I had forgotten to take them with me, so I slept in my underpants.

We both slept in a double bed at her place. I think it would have been about eleven o'clock when I went to bed, because Father DAY and myself had both been to the pictures. We had been to the 'BERCY' in the city. I can't remember the name of the picture we saw, but I remember that Father DAY held my hand all through the duration of the picture.

I went to bed first, only in My underpants, and some time later he came to bed also. I can't remember how long, but about half an hour. I was half asleep when he came into the room, and I saw him get undressed and put on his pyjamas. He then turned out the light and got into bed with me.

Some five or ten minutes later Father DAY who was in bed with me put his hand inside my underpants and started fondling with my penis for one or two minutes.

When this occurred I didn't take much notice of it, as I was half asleep and I thought that at the time he was just rolling over in his sleep. The time he was fondling with my penis he never said anything to me, or suggested anything in any way, and I didn't say anything to him. I was only young at the time, and was not fully aware of what was taking place.

When I arrived back in Mildura, some two or three days later I told him what had happened in bed with Father DAY, and told him that I didn't want to go on a trip away with him again.

At the end of 1965 I left the school and have not had anything to do with Father DAY since.
