Ref. 372/39 Bindoon.

I have for acknowledgment your letter of the 20th re above. The housing conditions referred to have since been the subject of enquiry and adjustment, and in reply to your letter I desire to advise that whilst the Sisters of a Religious Order cannot be immediately established, two additions to the female staff have been arranged.

The question of later establishment of the Sisters has been referred to the proper authorities.

I may comment that your reference in the concluding paragraph, to a staff of Sisters being previously arranged for, does not apply to Bindoon. There has been no undertaking in this respect so far as Bindoon is concerned.
