I understand that Major J. Sumsion is being transferred from Nedlands Boys' Home. I have written to him, expressing the Department's appreciation of his work.

I write now to remind you of the terms applying to the Government's subsidy for the building of the new Cottages. These were contained in letters dated 17th September, 1964, from the Hon. the Premier to Lieut.-Commissioner Scotney, and 9th September, 1965, to Mr. I.M. Suter to the effect that the staff selected is to be acceptable to the Director of Child Welfare.

As each of the new Cottages was completed, it was staffed without reference to this Department. I would appreciate now an opportunity for consultation on the appointment of Major Sumsion's successor.
