Dear Rabbi Glick

Further to our telephone conversation on 19 November 2012 I advise that the Victorian Institute of Teaching (the Institute) has received a complaint against you from [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] has alleged that as a registered teacher at Yeshivah College, you failed to report alleged sexual abuse incidents within your knowledge to relevant authorities. As I indicated during our telephone discussion, [REDACTED] submitted his complaint to the Victorian Registration & Qualifications Authority (VRQA) who determined that it should be referred to the Institute as it contained allegations about the behaviour of an individual teacher.

The Institute has conducted inquiries with Victoria Police who are investigating historical allegations of sexual assault relating to former employees of Yeshivah College and Detective Senior Sergeant Michael Dwyer of the Sexual Crimes Squad has requested that [REDACTED] complaint be forwarded to Victoria Police. 9611-8703

In all the circumstances, the Institute considers it appropriate to accede to the request from Victoria Police to forward the complaint to Detective Senior Sergeant Michael Dwyer of the Sexual Crimes Squad and the complainant has been advised about that referral.

While the Victoria Police investigation is ongoing, the Institute does not propose to take any further action although the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* (Vic) places an obligation on the Chief Commissioner of Victoria Police to advise the Institute if certain charges are laid against teachers. In those circumstances, the Institute proposes to monitor the outcome of the police investigation to review any further action that may be required.
