We understand that charges have now been laid against Mr David Cyprys and that some of these charges may relate to former students of the College during the 1980s and early 1990s.

The College would like to assure our students, families and the broader community that we have all possible measures in place, to provide a safe and secure environment at the College.

In circumstances where the charges are before the Court, it would be inappropriate for the College to comment further at this time.

However, the College again expresses its sympathy to those who may have been affected in any way. We continue to stand ready to offer support and provide counselling to anyone who feels this would be of benefit to them.

In the meantime, the College continues to cooperate fully with the Police.
