Dear All,

As per our meeting tonight, the following are the proposed Mikveh Rules to be sent to all mikvah & Yeshiva Shul members and put up at the Mikvah:

1) Children 12 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent/guardian

2) Teenagers 13-17 must provide written permission by parent/guardian to use the mikveh. This can be done as an email to shaul Schapiro. (Below is a draft consent form)

3) If you are concerned that any inappropriate or unlawful behaviour has occurred in the Mikvah, please immediately report the incident to Shaul Schapiro at the the following phone number/email address and/or notify the relevant law enforcement authority.

It was also agreed that Shaul would discuss the following matters with Greg Fisher:

1) Liability issues in relation to Mikvah entity & or the necessity of a lease

2) Access to be restricted by installation of a Card system for members together with a coin option for guests

3) Installation of External CCTV

I will B"H liaise with Melbourne to see if they have any other rules that may be of interest etc.
