

## "ATTACHMENT 25"

On behalf of the [REDACTED] family, we acknowledge and appreciate the statement below from Rabbi Glick. It is an important step towards healing for us as individuals and our community.

**Rabbi Glick makes this statement in good faith to acknowledge and address the pain and suffering, bullying and harassment experienced by [REDACTED] and his family in recent years.**

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1. [REDACTED] was and is in no way associated with the false accusations made against Rabbi Glick in 2013. Rabbi Glick publicly, absolutely and definitively clears [REDACTED] or his family of any wrong doing.
2. Rabbi Glick calls on any and all parties connected with this situation, and the community generally, to immediately and for all time restore the good name of [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED] family and to stop completely any and all negativity towards them.
3. Rabbi Glick cannot take direct responsibility for the decisions or actions of others. However, he is very sorry and upset that [REDACTED] and his family suffered from false accusations, hateful actions and deplorable comments made against [REDACTED] by people claiming to be acting on Rabbi Glick's behalf or in his name since 2013. Those individuals were not acting on Rabbi Glick's authority.
4. Rabbi Glick publicly deplores any hateful activity towards [REDACTED] or his family. Rabbi Glick is deeply sorry for the distress caused to an innocent individual and his family by such actions.
5. As part of Rabbi Glick's sincere self-reflection on the matter, and despite the efforts Rabbi Glick did make, he recognises that he may have had opportunities where he could have taken steps or done more to stop discussions, loshen hara and rumours about [REDACTED]. We must all commit in future to shut down any hateful rumours within the community and stop them proliferating.
6. Rabbi Glick admires and respects the strength and courage shown by [REDACTED] to ensure justice was achieved in his own case. He also admires and encourages the efforts [REDACTED] has made and continues to make to support others to achieve justice in their cases.
